

## LEGAL NOTICE

### TOWN OF GREECE 2015 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM

As part of our public participation process, the Town of Greece is required to post a legal notice to prepare for the upcoming Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application process, as part of grants funds received from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the Town's 2015 program year, which begins August 1, 2015.

To the best of the Town's ability, all funds will be used to continue existing programs and to identify new community development activities that principally benefit low to moderate-income persons. Low to moderate-income citizens are encouraged to participate in the Consolidated Plan process by proposing projects that serve community needs and by commenting on projects underway by the Town.

A **public hearing**, in conjunction with Monroe County Department of Planning and Development, will be held on **Wednesday, January 14, 2015 at 9:30 a.m.** in the large conference room of the Ebenezer Watts Conference Center, 49 South Fitzhugh Street, Rochester, New York. The facility is ADA accessible. Please take this opportunity to express your views on the current and future use of CDBG funds that support a variety of housing, community and economic development activities in the program area.

Application packets will be available beginning January 12, 2015. **The submission deadline for applications is Friday, February 20, 2015 at 5:00 p.m.** Applications will also be made available on the Town of Greece's website at [www.greeceny.gov](http://www.greeceny.gov).

The Town of Greece has not yet received notification from HUD in regard to their 2015 allocation. For planning purposes, the town has been advised to proceed based on actual funding received in 2014, which made \$434,690 available for CDBG programs.
