

Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Town Board, Town of Greece, Monroe County held October 21, 2021 at the Town Hall, One Vince Tofany Boulevard, Rochester, New York at 6:00 p.m.

Due to the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) and Delta variant, Governor Hochul has ordered that the requirements of the Open Meetings Law be modified as they were pursuant to Executive Order 220.1. As such, the Greece Town Board meeting of October 21, 2021 was held electronically via Facebook Live instead of a meeting open for the public to attend in person. Members of the public were able to view the Board meeting by logging onto Facebook and viewing the live feed under "Bill Reilich Greece Town Supervisor."

Supervisor Reilich called the meeting to order at 6:04 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Supervisor Reilich called upon Councilman Mike Barry to lead the Town Board in the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Reilich held a Moment of Silent Prayer and Reflection.

PRELIMINARY 2022 TOWN OF GREECE BUDGET FOR INTRODUCTORY PURPOSES ONLY:

Supervisor Reilich called upon Jon Hellmann, Budget Director to present an introduction overview of the 2022 tentative Town Budget. He also stated that public comments on the presentation could be submitted to the Town Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on November 18, 2021 at which time they would be read aloud in order of being received during the Public Hearing.

The members of the Town Board asked several questions and provided comments on the thorough development of the tentative 2022 Town Budget by the Finance Department including all department heads.

PUBLIC HEARING:

6:15 p.m. – Public hearing to consider the request for a special use permit submitted by Li-Cycle North American Hub, Inc. for a hydrometallurgical recycling facility, including chemical and petroleum bulk storage pursuant to §211-18C(3) of the Town of Greece Zoning Ordinance, to be located within Eastman Business Park, generally south of Ridgeway Avenue and east of Lee Road.

Supervisor Reilich declared the public hearing open at 6:30 p.m. to consider the request submitted by Li-Cycle North American Hub, Inc. for a hydrometallurgical recycling facility, including chemical and petroleum bulk storage pursuant to §211-18C(3) of the Town of Greece Zoning Ordinance, to be located within Eastman Business Park, generally south of Ridgeway Avenue and east of Lee Road.

Proof of publication in the Daily Record on October 12, 2021 was received. Representatives of Li-Cycle North American Hub, Inc. provided an overview of the project and questions were asked by the Town Board.

Supervisor Reilich then asked for a motion to leave the Public Hearing open in order to receive comments on the application from the residents. He further stated that comments could be submitted to the Town Clerk by 5:00 p.m. on November 18, 2021. All comments received would be read aloud in order and would be addressed by the applicant at the next Town Board meeting.
