

Town of Greece Tree Service Permit Program

Who needs to be permitted?

- Companies/Contractors conducting residential and local business tree removal/trimming in the Town of Greece
- Companies/Contractors conducting tree removal/trimming for RG&E/Frontier Telephone/Other Utilities.

Permit NOT required

- Companies/Contractors conducting mass clearing for local development projects

Annual Permit to run April 1, 2020 – March 31, 2021

- Renewal letters to be sent by the Town on or about February 1st
- Paperwork to be returned to the Town no later than March 15th
- Permit applications accepted throughout the year, but effective dates remain

Permit fee: \$50.00 first truck. \$25 each additional truck

- Permit stickers required for all trucks working on a job site
- Permit sticker must be attached and clearly displayed on the front bumper
- Tree Service Business to still receive annual Certificate of Registration

Schedule to unload approved material at Town of Greece Transfer Station, 635 Flynn Road

April 1st – October 31st

Monday – Friday only

11:00AM – 2:00PM

(Must arrive by 2:00PM. No dumping outside program schedule)

- Drivers unloading approved material at Town of Greece Transfer Station must check in with town staff, show contract or invoice with the Greece address where work was completed and will be directed to specific location to drop off material.
- Driver is responsible for and must provide proof to town staff that No Ash tree material is included with any load.

Approved material acceptable for drop off

- Trees and limbs (No Ash Trees)
- Town reserves the right to deny any load that does not comply with these standards

Material NOT accepted at Town of Greece Transfer Station (Including but not limited to)

- Trees/Trimming/Wood Chips from properties located outside the Town of Greece
- Any Ash trees/trimmings/wood chips (Due to Emerald Ash Borer, no Ash tree material will be accepted)
- Ground/Chipped trees and limbs
- Brush/plant type material from landscaping projects
- Material cleared from local development projects
- Any trees/limbs over 24" diameter
- Tree stumps, root balls or any trees/limbs with organic material mixed in
- Stump grindings
- Grass clippings
- Dirt/Fill
- Concrete
- Any material not listed above but deemed unacceptable by town staff

Penalties

- Failure to comply with the stipulations set forth in the Town of Greece Tree Service Permit Program could result in the suspension or revocation of all Tree Service Permits.
